**Article 1 Purpose:** This Regulations has been established to reward full-time faculty members and researchers (including post-doctoral researchers) for excellence in academic research and contributions to NTNU's academic reputation.

**Article 2 Eligible subjects:**

Any NTNU full-time faculty members or researcher who has won Presidential Science Prizes, Executive Yuan Award for Outstanding Science and Technology Contribution, National Award for Arts, National Cultural Award (Executive Yuan), Academic Award (Ministry of Education), National Professorship Award (Ministry of Education), Outstanding Scholar Award (Foundation For The Advancement of Outstanding Scholarship), Outstanding Achievement Award (Hou Chin-Dwei Foundation), Outstanding Research Award (NSTC), Ta-You Wu Memorial Award (NSTC), Research Fellow Award (NSTC), Award for Excellent Contributions in Technology Transfer (NSTC), or Academia Sinica Early-Career Investigator Research Achievement Award in the year of application.

**Article 3 Amount of Reward:**

- (I) Faculty members and researchers (including post-doctoral researchers) who satisfy any of the criteria listed in Article 2 are entitled to a reward of NT\$100,000 per person.
- (II) Candidates who satisfy more than one criteria in the same year shall be rewarded once only (the best of which). Each person is entitled to one reward per year. This reward shall be spent on research project related expenses.

**Article 4 Source of funds:** This reward shall be funded by NTNU under the account - Academic Research Promotion.

**Article 5** Before the end of March each year, the Office of Research and Development is required to prepare a list of last year's award winners and, with the consent of the President, notify award winners to claim for the abovementioned expenses according to NTNU's accounting policies.

Article 6 The Regulations has been passed with resolutions sought from a Research and Development Council, and implemented with the approval of the President. The same applies to all subsequent amendments.
