Regulations for Establishing the Endowed Chair

Approved by the 6th Academic Meeting of the 2018 Academic Year (2/27/2019) Approved by the 107th Endowment Fund Committee (3/22/2019) Amended by the 15th Academic/Administrative Directors Joint Meeting in the 2021 Academic Year (3/23/2022) Amended by the 124th Endowment Fund Committee (4/13/2022) Article 1 The NTNU Regulations for Establishing the Endowed Chair were formulated to encourage enterprises to sponsor NTNU in selecting and recruiting faculty members with outstanding achievements in industry–academia cooperation as well as special academic achievements.

Article 2 Chair qualifications: Full-time certified NTNU professors or internationally renowned scholars with academic honors or outstanding achievements in industry and academia.

Article 3 Chair title: To be negotiated by the recipient and the donor.

Article 4 Principles for establishing an endowed chair:

NTNU units receiving endowments must formulate guidelines for establishing endowed chairs; the guidelines for those receiving endowments in the name of NTNU shall be determined by the Office of Research and Development.

The guidelines for establishing department-level and college-level endowed chairs shall be reviewed by the College Affairs Meeting; those for establishing the endowed chairs of university-level centers and administrative units shall be reviewed by the Academic Meeting. The aforementioned guidelines must include the purpose of establishment, chair title, term of office, review procedure, endowment unit and amount, and rights and obligations of endowed chairs.

- Article 5 Endowed chairs must be committed to improving NTNU's academic standards and capacity for industry–academia cooperation and to assisting in tasks related to academics and industry–academia cooperation.
- Article 6 Term of office: One year by principle; the term length may be extended through endowment contracts when necessary.
- Article 7 Source of funding: Endowments from off-campus organizations.
- Article 8 The Regulations and amendments thereof shall be implemented after approval by the Academic Meeting, the Endowment Fund Committee, and the President of NTNU.
