National Taiwan Normal University Instrumentation Center Foundation Regulations

October 5, 2011 Passed during the 333rd Administrative Council

Article 1 The National Taiwan Normal University Instrumentation Center Foundation

Regulations (the Regulations) has been established in accordance with

Article 9 of the NTNU The University Charter to facilitate resource

sharing and enable proper maintenance and use of major instruments.

Article 2 Objectives of the Instrumentation Center (the Center):

- I. Coordinate use of major instruments owned by NTNU.
- II. Manage and maintain instruments registered under the Center.
- III. Provide service and assistance to research projects both within and outside NTNU.
- IV. Enable industry-academia cooperation on technological development.
- Article 3 The Center shall be headed by an NTNU instructor with assistant professor position or above, or a researcher of equivalent grade. The candidate will be recommended by the Vice President for Research and Development for the President's approval. The Center may hire administrative staff as needed. Recruitment, performance evaluation, reward and discipline of the hired staff shall comply with NTNU policies.

Article 4 To facilitate operations, the Center must establish policies to govern the types of instruments to be subjected under its management, the responsibilities of hired personnel, how instruments should be managed, and funding of the Center.

Article 5 These Regulations have been implemented with approvals sought from an Administrative Council. The same applies to all subsequent amendments.
